



WHEN ANIMOSITIES BETWEEN A PASTOR AND HIS BARTENDER DAUGHTER RESULT IN A LAWSUIT BETWEEN THEM, A MEDIATING JUDGE ORDERS THEM TO SWAP ROLES FOR A WEEK BEFORE PRONOUNCING JUDGMENT.

HIRAM "MAC" MCCOY IS A SINGLE FATHER AND PASTOR, AND JODIE MCCOY IS HIS BARTENDER DAUGHTER. THE TWO HAD ALWAYS BEEN CLOSE UNTIL PERSONAL RESENTMENTS CAUSED JODIE TO SUE HER FATHER FOR HER SHARE OF THE FAMILY HOUSE, WHERE MAC LIVES AFTER THE ACCIDENTAL DEATH OF HIS WIFE, MEREDITH. SO JODIE FILES A LAWSUIT FOR THE HOUSE TO BE SOLD AND ITS PROCEEDS DIVIDED BETWEEN THEM.

MEREDITH'S DEATH IS THEIR BONE OF CONTENTION, WITH EACH BLAMING THE OTHER FOR WHAT OCCURRED, WHICH WAS JODIE RUNNING OUT OF GAS IN HER CAR AGAIN AFTER HAVING BEEN WARNED MULTIPLE TIMES BY HER DAD NOT TO DRIVE ON AN EMPTY TANK. AS BEFORE, JODIE CALLED HER DAD FOR HELP AS SHE WAS STRANDED ON THE SHOULDER OF A HIGHWAY. BUT MAC WAS IN YET ANOTHER CHURCH MEETING, WHICH JODIE CLAIMS WAS ALWAYS HIS PRIORITY. SO MAC CALLED MEREDITH, WHO WAS KILLED WHEN A DELIVERY TRUCK SUFFERED A BLOWOUT AND THE WHEEL RIM SNAPPED OFF AND STRUCK MEREDITH.



ON THEIR APPOINTED DAY IN COURT, THE TWO ARE CALLED INTO THE JUDGE'S CHAMBERS, WHERE THEY BREAK INTO ANOTHER ARGUMENT OF BACK-AND-FORTH SHOUTING, WITH EACH DEFENDING THEIR OWN ACTIONS BEFORE DENOUNCING THE OTHER AS NOT KNOWING WHAT IT'S LIKE "TO WALK IN MY SHOES."

NEITHER IS WILLING TO LISTEN, FORGIVE, OR EVEN ATTEMPT TO UNDERSTAND THE OTHER.

SO THE JUDGE ORDERS THEM TO SWAP ROLES FOR A WEEK. MAC MUST TEND BAR AND JODY MUST RUN THE CHURCH. AT THE END OF THIS TRIAL PERIOD, THE JUDGE SAYS SHE WILL ISSUE A DECISION. BEFORE RELEASING THEM, HOWEVER, SHE ADVISES THEM TO WORK THIS OUT. "YOU'VE ALREADY EXPERIENCED ENOUGH LOSS. DON'T LET ANOTHER DEATH DIVIDE YOU ... PERMANENTLY."






MAIN CAST



MEGGIE JENNY HAS BEEN NOMINATED TWICE AS THE "PEOPLE'S CHOICE" ACTRESS OF THE YEAR. SHE HAS OVER FIFTY FILM AND TELEVISION CREDITS TO HER NAME, HAS WON AWARDS AS BEST ACTRESS AND BEST SUPPORTING ACTRESS, AND HAS WRITTEN, PRODUCED, AND STARRED IN THE TWO FEATURE FILMS, CHRISTMAS AT KEESTONE AND WEDDING AT KEESTONE. MEGGIE PLAYS THE ROLE OF JODIE MCCOY, THE BARTENDER DAUGHTER OF PASTOR MAC MCCOY.



ACTOR, SCREENWRITER, AND EXECUTIVE PRODUCER WAYNE DELORIEA HAS BEEN IN SHOW BUSINESS MORE THAN THIRTY YEARS, WITH SINGING CREDITS AND MORE THAN A DOZEN FILM AND TELEVISION CREDITS TO HIS NAME. WAYNE HAS BEEN CAST BEFORE IN "TOUGH GUY" ROLES, AND SAYS THE PART OF PASTOR MAC MCCOY DEMANDED HIS BEST IN WAYS HE NEVER COULD HAVE IMAGINED.



AWARD-WINNING ACTRESS CATHERINE TRAIL, WHO PLAYS THE PART OF JUDGE FLORINDA THOMAS, BOASTS A LONG LIST OF NATIONAL AND REGIONAL TELEVISION COMMERCIALS, AS WELL AS MORE THAN SIXTY FILM CREDITS. HOST OF *ON THE RED CARPET WITH CATHERINE TRAIL*, WHERE SHE INTERVIEWS ASPIRING ACTORS, SHE ALSO CO-WROTE AND PRODUCED "FOUR PIES," BASED ON THE LIFE OF HER MOTHER, WHICH WON ACCOLADES AT FILM FESTIVALS AROUND THE WORLD.

WITH MORE THAN THIRTY FILM AND TELEVISION CREDITS TO HIS NAME, *SQUARE PEGS* DIRECTOR, THE LATE BILL RAHN, WAS UNSURPASSED AT STRETCHING A DOLLAR INTO THREE. I LEFT AS A PRODUCER, EXECUTIVE PRODUCER, EDITOR, PROPS MAN, CATERER, DRIVER, AND DISHWASHER." *SQUARE PEGS* WAS BILL'S FINAL FILM BEFORE HIS UNTIMELY DEATH."

SCREENURITER


JAMES HOUSTON TURNER IS THE WINNER OF NUMEROUS AWARDS, INCLUDING "BEST THRILLER" FOR HIS TALANOV SERIES OF SPY NOVELS + SIX "BEST SCREENPLAY" AWARDS FOR HIS SCRIPTS, INCLUDING THREE FOR SQUARE PEGS.

AFTER A NATIONAL TELEVISION TOUR WITH HIS POTATO COOKBOOK, HE BECAME A JOURNALIST AT THE FAMED UNION RESCUE MISSION OF LOS ANGELES, WHERE HE LED A DOUBLE LIFE AS A BIBLE SMUGGLER BEHIND THE FORMER IRON CURTAIN. HE HAS MADE SEVERAL TOURS ACROSS AMERICA WITH HIS BOOKS. AND APPEARED ON DOZENS OF TELEVISION AND RADIO SHOWS. HE HAS SPOKEN TO THOUSANDS OF STUDENTS ON HIS "TOO UGLY TOUR" ABOUT THE HARD KNOCKS OF LIFE AND HOW THEY ARE SOME-TIMES BLESSINGS IN DISGUISE. THE TOUR WAS NAMED FROM THE TIME HE WAS REFUSED A CUSTOMER SERVICE JOB BECAUSE HE WAS "TOO UGLY" - A REFERENCE TO THE "UNSIGHTLY" FACIAL SCARS FROM HIS SUCCESSFUL CANCER OPERATION, WHERE DOCTORS REMOVED A LARGE TUMOR FROM HIS JAW. AT THE TIME, HE WAS GIVEN EIGHTEEN MONTHS TO LIVE; IT HAS NOW BEEN MORE THAN THIRTY-THREE YEARS.



"GOD DOES INDEED MOVE IN MYSTERIOUS WAYS," HE SAYS, "BECAUSE THAT JOB REFUSAL FORCED ME TO PERSEVERE WITH MY WRITING, WHICH IS WHY I AM NOW AN AUTHOR, SCREENWRITER, AND FILM PRODUCER."

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LIKE THE CHARACTER OF MAC MCCOY, I ATTENDED SEMINARY WHILE WORKING IN A CHURCH AND A BAR. THE EXPERIENCE REVEALED SOME SURPRISING SIMILARITIES BETWEEN THE TWO ENVIRONMENTS, WHICH, DECADES LATER, CAME IN VERY HANDY FOR MY WRITING OF SQUARE PEGS.

THE MOVIE CONTAINS THREE INTERTWINED THEMES, WITH THE FIRST BEING FORGIVENESS, WHICH IS NOT ALWAYS AN EASY COMMAND TO OBEY. WHEN MY MOTHER WAS DYING OF PANCREATIC CANCER, SHE WAS BITTER FROM ALL OF THE WRONGS COMMITTED AGAINST HER OVER A SPAN OF MORE THAN FIFTY YEARS. I REMEMBER SITTING ON THE EDGE OF HER HOSPITAL BED, SAYING, "LET IT GO, MOM, AND FORGIVE. NONE OF IT MATTERS, ANYWAY, AND WE NEED TO FORGIVE OTHERS JUST AS WE WANT GOD TO FORGIVE US." SHE DID, AND I CAN STILL SEE HER BITTERNESS MELTING AWAY INTO A SMILE OF JOY AND PEACE. THREE DAYS LATER, SHE DIED, FORGIVEN BY GOD, WHICH IS WHY THE THEME OF FORGIVENESS IS SO PERSONAL TO ME. I KNOW FIRSTHAND THE LIBERATION — AND LIFE — IT BRINGS.


THE SECOND THEME IS THAT OF DISCOVERING WHERE WE BELONG IN LIFE ... AND WHERE WE DON'T, WHICH IS WHERE THE "TRADING PLACES" SIDE OF THE STORY COMES IN. MANY OF US HAVE BEEN RUDDERLESS AT SOME POINT, SO I DECIDED TO THROW MAC AND JODIE INTO THAT SAME "DEEP END" AND ALLOW AUDIENCES TO WATCH WHAT HAPPENS. BUT I ALSO

WANTED TO HAVE SOME FUN, AND PART OF THAT FUN INVOLVED A PICKLED-EGG-EATING CHALLENGE, WHICH MEGGIE JENNY PERFORMED BRILLIANTLY. THE END CREDITS OF THE FILM PROVIDE SOME HILARIOUS BTS CLIPS OF MEGGIE'S CHALLENGERS.

THE THIRD THEME IS THAT OF CHURCH, WHICH IS NOT WHERE WE GO, BUT WHO WE ARE. THE EXAMPLE WE SEE IN SCRIPTURE IS THAT OF JESUS WASHING FEET, WHICH IN THAT DAY WAS THE MOST DEGRADING OF JOBS. "THE GREATEST AMONG YOU SHALL BE THE LEAST," WE ARE TOLD IN THE BOOK OF JOHN. MAC AND JODIE DISCOVER THE DEMANDS AND REWARDS OF LIVING THE TRUTH OF THOSE WORDS IN THE CONTRASTING WORLDS OF A CHURCH AND A BAR, INCLUDING A SCENE WHERE VANDALS NEARLY BURN DOWN THE BUILDING WHERE MAC IS PASTOR.
